If your group grows beyond the reserved space or if an unforeseen conflict arises, please contact Camp Thunderbird as soon as possible in order to accommodate this growth. A cancellation of your reserved space at Camp Thunderbird requires at least 4 months notification. Schools that cancel less than 120 days prior to the reserved date will be required to pay a percentage of the fee based on the following cancellation schedule. The cancellation penalty will not be charged if Camp Thunderbird is able to reschedule another group of equal or greater size.

Cancellation Policy:

30-day notice	50% of the fee
31-60 day notice	40% of the fee
61-90 day notice	30% of the fee
91-120 day notice	20% of the fee

Deposit Schedule:

3 Day trip:	\$250
2 Day trip:	\$250
1 Day trip:	\$75

Payment: Enclose deposit and contract to secure your date and space. Balance to be paid in full.

Agreement:

1. The group will clean occupied buildings and adjacent grounds before leaving. Neglecting to meet this provision will result in additional charges for service and labor.
2. Groups are responsible for turning off lights and closing doors upon departure of the building.
3. Damage to or loss of, equipment, and/or facilities will be paid for by the group.
4. Pets may not be brought to or housed on camp grounds or in camp facilities.
5. Alcohol/drugs in any form are not permitted on the premises unless prescribed by a licensed physician.
6. Fires are allowed only in the amphitheater fire ring. All fires must be pre-arranged with a Director.
7. Groups or individuals are not permitted on the docks at any time.
8. No smoking is allowed in any camp building. Please dispose of cigarette butts properly.
9. Canoeing and swimming must be prearranged and must have the required number of certified Thunderbird lifeguards on duty. **SWIMMING IN THE LAKE IS STRICTLY FORBIDDEN!**
10. Firearms, ammunition, flammable liquids, explosives and poisonous substances are forbidden on property.
11. User groups must provide their own linens for overnight visits.
12. The school/organization is responsible for dispensing all medication. It is also the responsibility of the school to provide transportation for any medical emergency. For emergency assistance dial 911 or refer to Medical Facilities Sheet.
13. Thunderbird does not provide accident or medical insurance for visiting groups.
14. User groups must provide certificate of insurance 6 weeks prior to visit.

STATEMENT: THE SIGNER (WHO IS AT LEAST 21 YEARS OF AGE) HAS READ THE CONTRACT, INFORMED THE GROUP ABOUT THE RULES AT CAMP THUNDERBIRD, AND THE SIGNER, AS A SCHOOL OFFICIAL, ACCEPTS RESPONSIBILITY FOR ANY NEGLIGENT ACTS BY MEMBERS OF THE SCHOOL GROUP THAT OCCUR WHILE THE GROUP IS ON THE CAMP PROPERTY.
